DESCRIPTION and OBJECTIVES:

A practicum for preparing candidates for ordination as Deacons in the Roman Catholic Church.

Prerequisite: Theology of Worship.

This course advances the mission of Aquinas Institute by preparing candidates for the Diaconate to celebrate those sacramental rites proper to a Deacon and to integrate these ministerial skills into an ecclesial and pastoral context for ministry. It will include a brief consideration of the history and theology of the diaconate, will explore issues of ministerial identity, and will stress the art of presiding.

PROCEDURES:

There will be a mixture of lecture and *practica* experiences, which will involve peer response and critique.

EVALUATION:

This course is graded on a pass/fail basis. A passing grade is earned by successful execution of assigned *practica*, engagement in class discussion, and a final integrative reflection paper.
