Description

A practicum designed for those preparing for ordination as a Priest in the Roman Catholic Church. *Prerequisites: Theology of Worship; Liturgical Leadership II.*

Objectives

This practicum seeks to integrate the ministerial skills required of a priest in the Roman Catholic Church into an ecclesial and pastoral context for ministry. The course will stress the Art of Presiding, especially at the celebration of the Eucharist and in the Ministry of Reconciliation.

Procedures

Practica experiences which will involve peer response and critique are the primary focus of this course. The *practica* experiences will follow lecture and class discussion of what is required of a priest in a given ministerial setting.
