### Registration Information

If your employer will be paying your tuition, you may send them the link provided in Populi or use your corporate credit card to make a payment. Statements may be printed from your Populi account. Please be attentive to the course and section numbers. The section number for this cohort will always remain the same. **Example: HCM-T500-19 or HCM-F-505-19** EMAHCM registration is by term. Payment of tuition and fees for both sessions are due by the beginning of the term (the exact date will be posted on your invoice).

### Registration Process

Meet with your academic advisor to discuss your progress in the program. After you have met with your advisor, they will remove the registration lock on your Populi account. Log in to Populi in order to register for courses.

Fees and any financial aid awards will be added to your account before an invoice is created. Invoices are created once the registration period has ended (see dates on the academic calendar). Please check your account for accuracy before the registration period has ended.

After your account has been invoiced, you will be able to make your payment to complete your registration. Full payment (or a payment plan) must be made before the semester begins. Aquinas does not bill third parties for payment. There is, however, a link from your Populi account which you can send to allow others to pay your tuition. The student is responsible for tuition and fees. If a student has not paid by the due date, they will be removed from the course until payment arrangements can be made.
